RE: **APET Plastic Sheeting**

This is further to our letter of June 4, 2015 and in reference to your letter of February 6, 2015, wherein you requested our comment on the acceptability of the subject product for use in food packaging applications. This is also in response to your status queries of June 08, 2016 and July 21, 2016.

The subject film is intended to be used in the manufacture of containers for packaging salad and produce such as strawberries and blueberries, and in the manufacture of trays for packaging bakery products at the minimum and maximum temperature of -17°C to 65°C.

Based on the information provided, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the use of the subject product as proposed, provided it is technically suitable for the intended end-use.
